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## **Annex 3**

**Criteria for the evaluation of final tenders** 

#### Criteria for the evaluation of final tenders

The final bids of qualified bidders will be evaluated on the basis of the most economically advantageous bid in terms **of the best price-quality ratio** (according to Section 44 (3) (a) in conjunction with (b) of Act No. 343/2015 Coll. on Public Procurement).

In accordance with Section 96 (5) of the Public Procurement Act, the Contracting Authority lists the individual criteria for the evaluation of bids in **descending order of their importance**. The specific methodology for the evaluation of the final bids, including the method of assigning points, will be specified in the invitation to participate in the dialogue, which will be addressed to all qualified candidates, i.e. before the actual negotiations on the solutions offered. Hereby, the Contracting Authority complies with the principles of transparency and equal treatment (within the meaning of Section 10 (2) of the Public Procurement Act).

# Established criteria for the evaluation of the final bids and their order of importance:

#### Criterion 1: Price criterion,

- Within this criterion, the following sub-criteria will be assessed:
  - o **Initial fixed total price for the complete delivery of the work** (i.e. the total bid price, which will subsequently be indexed in accordance with the contractual conditions);
  - Lifecycle costs of key components
    - For this sub-criterion, consideration shall be given preliminarily to take into account the following aspects:
      - i. own electricity consumption, new key technological components,
      - ii. consumption of chemicals and operating media.
  - o The call for participation in the dialogue will set out the precise sub-criteria and methodology for evaluating their different aspects; The contracting authority reserves the right to change the evaluated aspect, but no later than the moment of sending the invitation to participate in the dialogue.

#### **Criterion 2: Technical criterion**

- Within this criterion, the following sub-criteria will be assessed:
  - o By the efficiency of the delivered equipment,
    - For this sub-criterion, consideration shall be given preliminarily to take into account the following aspects:
      - i. Gross electrical power at generator terminals,
      - ii. The availability of the equipment, or the time of their continuous operation of the boiler,
  - o The call for participation in the dialogue will set out the precise sub-criteria and methodology for evaluating their different aspects; The contracting authority reserves the right to change the evaluated aspect, but no later than the moment of sending the invitation to participate in the dialogue.

### Criterion No. 3: Time aspects of the execution of the work

- For this sub-criterion, consideration shall be given preliminarily to take into account:
  - o **Timeframe** of the implementation phases (i.e. earlier achievement of key project milestones);
  - o **The method and extent of minimizing technological shutdowns** (WTE, boiler and/or turbine) during the reconstruction.
- The call for participation in the dialogue will set out the precise sub-criteria and methodology for evaluating their different aspects; The contracting authority reserves the right to change the evaluated aspect, but no later than the moment of sending the invitation to participate in the dialogue.
